- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. The state of Alabama requires that all dogs be vaccinated against rabies.
- Please print or type all information on the entry form.
- Please show only dog's AKC titles on the entry form.
- Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the
 entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the trial. All
 entries must be made on official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include
 the Agreement and Rules. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be
 accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded except that of a bitch (minus \$10/day) who comes in season after being entered, by receipt of the Trial Secretary of a Veterinarian's Certificate to this effect prior to the start of the show. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the trial committee, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- HOTC will refund total entry fees less than \$10 per day for a handler that becomes sick or injured after the closing date. A medical doctor's excuse on the doctor's letterhead must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial.
- SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED.
- A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$4.50 will
 be required for each recordable single-entry class at any Licensed or Member Club
 Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A
 \$4.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel
 Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American
 Kennel Club.
- NO X-PENS ALLOWED IN BUILDING.
- NO CARPETS, RUGS OR "LIVING AREA" SET-UP ALLOWED IN BUILDING.
- NO UNENTERED DOGS ALLOWED IN BUILDING.
- Dogs should be present at least ½ hour before they are to be judged.
- Dogs will be crated or attended to at all times.
- The word **DOG** includes both sexes.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add
 a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check (this is the current
 amount charged for return checks in the city of Huntsville). Subsequent returned
 checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only
 hasis
- The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- All trophies should be claimed on the day of the show
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. Please help us keep the trial site and hotels clean.


